Arts Commission*: This is a seven-member board. Members must be residents of Carlsbad and normally serve four years.

Beach Preservation Committee: This is a seven-member committee of Carlsbad residents, with a minimum of three active members and two staff members to be appointed from Engineering and Planning Departments. Maximum term for any member shall be four years.

Carlsbad Tourism Business Improvement District Board*: This is a seven member board. Members must be hotel owners within the boundaries of the CTBID boundaries. Members serve terms as follows: no term limit = 3, four year term limit = 2, two year term limit = 2.

Historic Preservation Commission: This is a five member board appointed by the City Council and one ex-officio representative of the Planning Commission. All regular members must have knowledge of, and a demonstrated interest in, historic preservation and local history: three members, each of whom has a different recognized expertise in architecture, archaeology, history, biology, engineering or geology or related field; one member who has an interest in local history and has resided in the community for at least thirty years; and, one member at large from the community. Members normally serve four year terms.

Housing Commission*: This is a five-member board. Two members must be tenants assisted by the Carlsbad Housing Authority, one of which shall be at least 62 years of age; Three general members with experience or expertise in one or more of the following areas: development, construction, real estate, social services, housing advocacy, planning, architecture or finance. To the extent possible, the members shall be representative of the four quadrants of the City. Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters. The following term expired in 2011.
