A free, exciting history and interactive art lesson for fourth grade students in Carlsbad



- Reservations will become available to schools in other cities on October 9th for a fee.
- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis, and a maximum of 50 classes will be accepted. Only one class (up to 40 students) per day.
