National Public Lands Day is the nation’s largest, single-day volunteer effort aimed at educating the public about the environment and natural resources to improve public lands for outdoor recreation.

The volunteer trail work will include:

- Planting of shrubs and trees near trail entrance
- Post and rail fencing improvements and installation
- Vegetation trimming and weed removal
- Trail tread repair

The city will provide new volunteers with a short training on use of tools. The city will also provide shovels, McClouds, rakes, water and snacks.

Please wear closed-toe shoes, sunscreen and gloves. In the event of rain, this event will be canceled.
