# National Public Lands Day Saturday, Sept. 30

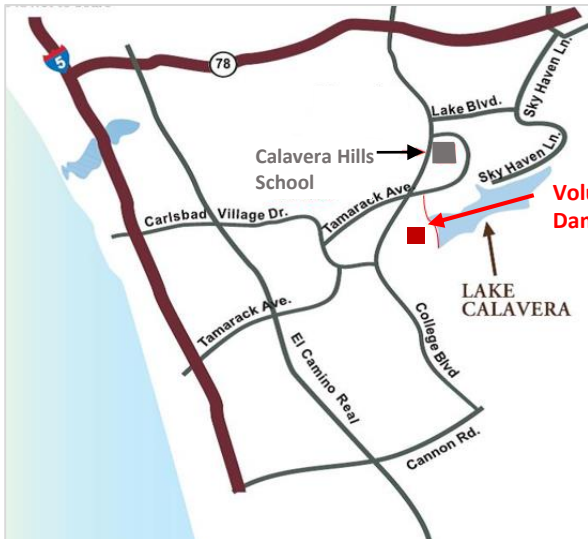
National Public Lands Day is the nation’s largest, single-day volunteer effort aimed at educating the public about the environment and natural resources to improve public lands for outdoor recreation.

**The volunteer trail work will include:**

- Trail vegetation trimming and weed removal
- Trail erosion repairs
- Litter removal
- Other miscellaneous trail maintenance

The city will provide new volunteers with a short training on use of tools. The city will also provide shovels, McClouds, rakes, water and snacks.
