AWARD: \$1,500

Support for artist-in-residence choreographer to assist in spring choir rehearsals, performances and competitions for over 150 students.

Carlsbad High School ASB (Drama)

AWARD: \$1,500

Support for artist-in-residence choreographer for 5 musical productions in April and May with the Musical Theatre Department.

Jefferson Elementary School PTA

AWARD: \$1,500

Support for preparation and rehearsals of a spring band concert for 50 students.

Carlsbad High School Band Boosters

AWARD: \$1,500

Support for auxiliary musical coaching staff for the CHS band program for over 100 students.

AWARD: \$1,500

AWARD: \$10,000

Support for “Cloud Tectonics”, an outreach and theatrical production taking place in January and February 2018 for an audience of over 2,500.

Museum of Making Music – Arts Project

AWARD: \$6,000

Support for “Summer Sounds” series of four summer concerts at the Museum of Making Music.

Mainly Mozart – Arts Project

AWARD: \$5,650

Support for two Spotlight chamber music concerts, at St. Elizabeth Set Church and Schulman Auditorium.

San Diego Dance Theater – Arts Education

AWARD: \$5,000

Support for “Aging Creatively Carlsbad” project that provides free, on-going professional dance training and performances to a diverse aging adult population with over 2,000 expected to participate. *New applicant.*
