Student Checklist

Please arrive promptly at **9 am** with students divided evenly into two groups prior to arrival. A park staff member will greet your class in the main parking area and provide further instruction.

What should the students and teachers wear/bring?

- Flat shoes, preferably sturdy sneakers or boots
- Appropriate outdoor clothing
- Water
- Sunscreen and/or a hat

Itinerary

9 a.m. Class arrives onsite and meets their docent and artist educator in parking lot. Class is split into two groups, **groups arranged prior to arrival.**

9:05 a.m. City staff will review park rules with students (for chaperones see below).

9:10 a.m. Students depart on their tour of the historic rancho and/or to the hands-on art making activity.

10:20 a.m. Class transitions to the next portion of the fieldtrip.

11:30 a.m. Program ends.

11:30 a.m. Optional picnic snack / lunch (please let staff know in advance if you'd like to picnic so we may reserve picnic area for your use)

The tour will last approximately 1 hour and consist of walking up to 1/2 mile on uneven terrain. Please let us know in advance if any students require any special accommodations to participate in the program.

Chaperone / Tour Etiquette

Thank you for accompanying the students on their visit to Leo Carrillo Ranch Historic Park. To help make their visit a memorable and valuable learning experience we kindly ask for your cooperation with the following:

- Please refrain from taking photos with the students during the tour portion of the program.
- Please have your cell phones turned to silent during the program.
- Please encourage the students to stay with their docent during the tour and model good listening behavior.
- Please accompany the students to the restroom as needed.
- A minimum of 1 chaperone per 10 student ratio is required to participate in the program
