Ansel Adams: Early Works | Sept. 23 – Dec. 2, 2019

Three-Part Art Dates: Oct. 7 – Nov. 13, 2019
Mon. – Wed. and select Thursdays
Registration starts Sept. 9, 2019

Intimate master prints from the 1920s through the 1950s depict Adam's transition from pictorialism to straight photography, and provide a fresh look at this legendary master of the American landscape. Presenting 42 photographs, several singular examples are included in this exhibition, including an extraordinary rare print of *Moonrise, Hernandez, NM, 1941*, and *Clearing Winter Story, 1938*, Adam's most celebrated Yosemite view.

For teachers and students this is an opportunity to learn about a master American photographer and be inspired by his work while thinking about and making art. Ansel Adam's photographic themes create connections to California History and English Language Arts curriculum.

This exhibition brings together three Southern California artists, Bhavna Mehta, Michelle Montjoy and Irma Sofia Poeter in a material-rich conversation about construction and connection. Using fine stitching and cutting, fraying fabrics and abstract shapes, text, color, texture, volume and shadow, their work weaves a narrative that seeks to clarify and extend the hidden layers of identity and understanding.

What Are The Three Parts?

PART 1

An online Teacher's Guide with a pre-visit lesson is available prior to the field trip to prepare students for their visit to the gallery.

PART 2

Teachers schedule a visit to the gallery where their class will take a tour with an Art Instructor and participate in creating a hands on art project relating to the current exhibit.

PART 3

Through the Teacher's Guide, teachers are provided with a post-visit activity and discussion topics that can be used to engage with their students after the field trip.
