Dear Ms. Moran:

In response to recent developments related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Carlsbad requests that all State of California Department of Parks & Recreation owned beaches, and parking lots adjacent to those beaches, within the city be immediately closed. This closure is being requested to reduce the potential for the public to make state beaches within Carlsbad a place of destination during our collective response to this crisis.

The city's request is consistent with State of California Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-33-20, issued on March 19, 2020, which reads in part:

To protect public health, I as State Public Health Officer and Director of the California Department of Public Health order all individuals living in the State of California to stay home or at their place of residence except as needed to maintain continuity of operations of the federal critical infrastructure sectors, as outlined in <https://www.cisa.gov/identifying-critical-infrastructure-during-covid-19>.

Thank you, in advance, for your anticipated cooperation with this public health related request. It is in the best interest of the people the State of California and the City of Carlsbad serve to close the subject beaches and parking lots immediately.
