About the commission

The Arts Commission is to advise the City Council on arts and culture related matters and implementation of the arts element of the Carlsbad General Plan.

The Arts Commission shall consist of seven members and shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council. Members serve four-year terms (unless appointed to fill an unexpired term).

Eligibility

Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters.

Meeting dates/times

Meetings are typically held on the first Thursday of every other month at 5:30 p.m.

Commission member requirements/duties

Attend commission meetings

File an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" form

Complete ethics training, fiscal and financial training and workplace harassment prevention training every two years

Review the Boards, Commissions and Committees Code of Ethics & Public Service Values

Appointment process

Applications are available on the city's website at www.carlsbadca.gov and in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall at 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad.

The Mayor will nominate applicants at a City Council meeting. Approval from a majority of the City Council is required to confirm the appointments.
