About the commission

The Environmental Sustainability Commission shall investigate, research and make recommendations to the City Council on topics, studies and programs related to:

- Natural resources and open space
- Beach nourishment and shoreline preservation
- Climate adaptation and environmental sustainability

The Environmental Sustainability Commission shall consist of seven members. The Mayor shall nominate three individuals and each Council Member shall nominate one individual for a term coinciding with the Council Member making the appointment. Members serve four-year terms (unless appointed to fill an unexpired term).

Eligibility

Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters.

Meeting dates/times

Regular meetings are held in the City Council chamber on the first Thursday of each even numbered month at 3 p.m.

Commissioner requirements/duties

Attend commission meetings

File an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" form

Complete ethics training, fiscal and financial training and workplace harassment prevention training every two years

Review the Boards, Commissions and Committees Code of Ethics & Public Service Values

Appointment process

Applications are available on the city's website at www.carlsbadca.gov and in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall at 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad.

The Council Member representing District 2 will nominate an applicant at a City Council meeting. Approval from a majority of the City Council is required to confirm the appointment.
